

HONE Sintered Stone (Porecelain) Maintenance Guide

Our beatiful range of Sintered Stone (Poreclain) offers exceptional durability, beauty, and ease of maintenance. This guide provides general information on cleaning, maintaining and caring for your HONE Sintered Stone surfaces.

1. General Cleaning Procedures

Daily Cleaning:

- Use a soft cloth or sponge with warm water and a mild, pH-neutral detergent.
- Wipe the surface clean, then rinse with water to remove any soap residue.
- o Dry the surface with a clean microfiber cloth to avoid water spots.

Removing Spills:

- o For most spills (e.g., coffee, wine, oil), wipe them up promptly with a damp cloth.
- For stubborn stains, apply a small amount of a non-abrasive cleaner and gently scrub with a soft sponge.

Deep Cleaning:

- Occasionally, use a non-abrasive, pH-neutral cleaner to remove any buildup or residue.
- Avoid products with harsh chemicals, such as bleach, ammonia, or acidic cleaners, as they may dull the surface.

2. Maintenance

- Preventing Scratches: While sintered stone is highly scratch-resistant, avoid using abrasive scrubbers, steel wool, or cutting directly on the surface. Use cutting boards for food preparation.
- Heat Protection: Although sintered stone is heat-resistant, prolonged exposure to extreme heat may cause thermal shock. Use trivets or heat pads under hot pots and pans.
- Avoid Impact Damage: Avoid dropping heavy objects on the surface, especially near edges or corners, to prevent chipping.

3. Special Care Instructions

• **Avoid Harsh Chemicals**: Do not use products containing hydrofluoric acid or its derivatives, as these can damage the surface.
